In 2016 ...

The number of women ordinands entering training increased by 19%.

Twenty dioceses increased their percentage of female incumbents. Ten saw their percentage decrease, and eleven stood still.
Only ten dioceses had over 30%. Nine had 20% or fewer.

Eleven dioceses had no women residentiary canons in their cathedrals.

In 2017 ...

Two new diocesan bishops were appointed. Neither of them were women.
